

TOWN OF STRONG – SELECTMEN’S MEETING MINUTES

November 10, 2020 @6:00pm

1. **Call meeting to order – flag salute**: Rob Elliott called the Selectmen’s Meeting to order with a flag salute at 6:00pm.
2. **Board Member Attendance Recognized**: Present: Rob Elliott, Jim Burrill, Rodney Cook, and Dick Worthley. Andy Pratt arrived 6:13pm. Others Attending: Sandra Mitchell and Betsy DuBois.
3. **Approval of the Selectmen’s Meeting Minutes from 10/27/2020**: Jim B. made a motion to approve minutes from the 10/27/2020 selectmen’s meeting. Dick Worthley 2nd the motion and all voted in favor (4-0).
4. **Approval of the Treasurer’s Warrant for week of 11/12/2020 for \$20,023.95**: Dick W. made a motion to approve Treasurer’s Warrant for week of 11/12/2020 for \$20,023.95. Jim B. 2nd the motion and all voted in favor.
5. **Town Septic**: Jim B. spoke with Mr. Warnock regarding the town septic cluster. He feels like the town pipe is on his side of line. He plans to get his property surveyed.
6. **Custodian**: Selectmen suggested the person that drives the 1 ton and also plows the town office yard could possibly help out with shoveling and walkways. They would like to run the Ad for another 2 weeks.
7. **Sign Approved Changes to Personnel Policy**: Selectmen signed the changes to the PP; bereavement and sick pay updates and the change of name from Columbus Day to Indigenous People’s Day. Jim B. made a motion to accept the approved changes to personnel policy. Rob 2nd the motion and all voted in favor (4-0).
8. **Reports of the Treasurer/Town Clerk/Highway Foreman**: Sandy reported that she still has some outstanding taxes on the foreclosure list. The town office changed over to the SQL platform with TRIO on Monday, November 9th.
9. **Selectmen’s Reports**: Rod Cook asked about the CMP letter that we received regarding LED street lights. Selectmen will review and discuss at next meeting. He said that he will be contacting Mike Carleton for help in getting the Christmas lights up soon. Andy P. said that he has gotten an estimate for the Park from Mike Yeaton of \$700. Andy made a motion to hire SMY & SPY landscaping to clean up the park based on an estimate of \$700. Dick W. 2nd the motion and all voted in favor (5-0). Rob E. announced that the town received a letter from our health care provider and there will be no increase in cost this year. He also mentioned that he has received concerns regarding getting the ditches cleared of brush before they freeze up for the winter. Andy said they were working on this.

Jim Burrill made a motion to adjourn. Dick W. 2nd and all voted in favor. Meeting adjourned at 6:22pm.
