- Property tax limit Article 6 , the assessing company is helping to find the number for this article 6. Once the number is received it will be entered.
- Surplus to reduce tax commitment Article 7 will be increase to \$300,00.00.
- Abatements - an article designating the fund the interest is coming from and a separate article for the interest paid.

➤ Winter Road Closing – an article will be added. To authorize the municipal officers to make final determinations regarding the closing or opening of roads to winter maintenance
